Representative Stan Rosenberg and Senator Olver's aide, David Sharkin, discussed the implications of the proposed cuts to Local Aid being considered by the Legislature.

Preparation for May 20th Town Meeting. 05-3-03

VOTED unanimously to support Article 24 (Keg Licensing By-Law) after amending it such that the fine for the first offense is \$200 and for the second and subsequent offenses, \$300.

VOTED 3-0-2 (Holstein and H. Brooks abstaining) to open the FY 92 Operating Budget to support the reduction of the Street Lights budget by \$34,240.

VOTED unanimously to recommend dismissal of Articles 4-17.

VOTED unanimously to support Article 18 which contains the correct dollar amount.

VOTED unanimously to recommend dismissal of Article 19.

VOTED 4-0-1 (H. Brooks abstaining) to recommend dismissal of Article 21.
